Transportation Projects Funding

- Funding Provided by AB 595 (2007)
- Portion of Room Tax to be assigned to Transportation improvements
- LVCVA Bonds for \$300 million



Completed Projects

- I-15 Express Lanes, I-215 to Sahara
 - 2007 – 2009
 - NDOT Contract 3355
 - \$21 million LVCVA funds



Completed Projects

- I-15 Express Lanes, I-215 to Sahara
 - Added one lane each direction on I-15
 - Two express lanes each direction
 - Improved travel times on critical stretch of I-15

Completed Projects

- I-15 South Design Build, Silverado Ranch to Tropicana Avenue
 - 2009 – 2012
 - NDOT Contract 3366DB
 - \$279 million LVCVA Funds

Completed I-15 Projects

- Average vehicle speeds increased on I-15 from Blue Diamond to South of Sahara
- Accidents, and accident severity, reduced on I-15 near the I-215 interchange
- Access to the South LV Strip increased with improvements to Tropicana and Russell interchanges



Tropicana Avenue @ LV Blvd.

- NDOT owns and maintains Tropicana Avenue
- Tropicana Avenue – LV Boulevard Pedestrian Bridges were the first such bridges built in LV (1992)
- Escalators expensive to maintain and poor service due to breakdowns

Tropicana Avenue @ LV Blvd.

- \$19.5 million remains from the \$300 million bond sale
- Previous I-15 projects are complete
- New agreement to spend the remaining money on improvements on Tropicana Avenue near LV Blvd.



Tropicana Avenue @ LV Blvd.

- Americans for Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements needed on Tropicana Avenue
- Safety improvements to existing barriers

Tropicana Avenue /LV Boulevard

- High pedestrian and vehicular volumes
- Project will improve the reliability of the pedestrian access to the bridges
- Improved escalators and machinery
- Coordination with the abutting resorts

Tropicana Avenue /LV Boulevard

- Tropicana Avenue improvements include handicap ramps, sidewalk upgrades, and replacement of barrier attenuators
- Upgraded aesthetics
