



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This permit authorizes the permitted group to voluntarily remove litter from within NDOT Right-of-Way along the shoulder from the edge of oil outward of the route location designated by this permit subject to the following conditions:

1. The permit shall be signed by PERMITTEE on page I and returned to the district office. The permit shall not be valid until the signed original permit has been received by the district office.
2. This temporary permit expires one year after the issued date. The PERMITTEE is required to re-apply on a yearly basis.
3. The temporary right-of-way occupancy permit shall be kept at the site of the event and must be shown to any representative of the department of transportation or any law enforcement officer on demand. The event shall be suspended if the permit is not at the site as provided.
4. The PERMITTEE, in addition to obtaining the temporary right-of-way occupancy permit must also obtain any and all other permits required by state law or local ordinances.
5. The PERMITTEE agrees to indemnify and save harmless the state of Nevada and its officers, agents, and employees against any and all liability, loss, damage, costs, fees and expense which it or they may incur, suffer, or be required to pay by reason of death, disease, or bodily injury to any person or persons, or injury to, destruction of, or loss of use of any property, including property belonging to the state of Nevada, arising out of or incident to activities contemplated by this permit, and proximately caused, in whole or in part, by any act or omission of the PERMITTEE, or its contractors, agents, or the employees of any one or all of them or by the officers, agents, or employees of the state of Nevada, unless it is established by the PERMITTEE that the proximate cause was the willful misconduct or gross negligence of the officers, agents, or employees of the state of Nevada.
6. The PERMITTEE acknowledges the hazardous nature of the work and efforts involved in contributing toward the effort of maintaining litter-free highways. More specifically, cleanup work can be in rough or treacherous areas, occasionally near vehicle traffic. Participants also may encounter unexpected and unidentified hazardous materials, which should not be touched but should be brought to NDOT's attention. The PERMITTEE and its members acknowledge and assumes these risks.
7. The PERMITTEE shall obtain required supplies and from the NDOT District Office at 702-385-6500, Monday-Friday, 8am-5pm, and must notify NDOT District Office five (5) working days in advance of right of way activity. PERMITTEE shall not occupy right of way on any state observed holiday and may occupy right of way on weekends that are not holidays.
8. The PERMITTEE shall ensure all persons, including new and alternate participants, execute a "Declaration of Participant" form prior to working in the public Right-of-Way, of which is attached as "Exhibit A". "NDOT Safety Requirements for Participants" and the "Declaration of Participant" forms are available for review and submission on the Nevada Department of Transportation website.
9. The PERMITTEE shall ensure all persons working in the public Right-of-Way wear OSHA approved reflective clothes, not limited to hats and vests and stay a reasonable and safe distance from passing traffic at all times. Up to twenty (20) reflective vests and twenty (20) reflective hats will be issued to the PERMITTEE. Quantities of orange bags provided for trash removal shall be issued on a case-by-case basis.
10. The PERMITTEE shall ensure that permit activities are ceased in the event of forecasted inclement weather conditions.
11. The PERMITTEE shall notify the NDOT District Office of any unusual circumstances, such as when large, heavy, or hazardous items are found, and it will be the DEPARTMENT's responsibility to remove such items from the adopted section.
12. PERMITTEE shall notify the NDOT District Office during regular business hours to coordinate the removal of bagged trash when needed. Please be prepared to provide your name, contact number, permit number, route, milepost segment, number of bags and location of the bags. Place bags in a location that is easily accessible for NDOT Maintenance staff.



13. The PERMITTEE shall notify the DEPARTMENT of any change in PERMITTEE Coordinator during the term of this permit. PERMITTEE Coordinators shall notify their NDOT District Office when their group has picked up litter.
14. The PERMITTEE shall ensure all persons working in the public Right-of-Way become familiar with and comply with the NDOT Safety Requirements for Participants, attached hereto, and incorporated herein as "Exhibit B".
- 15. The PERMITTEE shall ensure all persons working in the public Right-of-Way be a minimum of 18 years of age.**
16. Per NRS 484B.297, pedestrians walking along highways where sidewalks are not provided shall walk on the left side of those highways facing the approaching traffic.
17. The DEPARTMENT shall erect a sign at the beginning of the adopted section with the PERMITTEE's organization name displayed.
18. If, in the sole judgement of the NDOT District Office, it is found that the PERMITTEE is not meeting the terms and conditions of this permit, the NDOT District Office may revoke this permit and remove the PERMITTEE's sign.

This temporary right-of-way occupancy permit is granted to the PERMITTEE in accordance with the provisions of chapter 408 NRS, and subject to the terms and conditions stipulated to perform the work described.
