



**TITLE VI DISCRIMINATION COMPLAINT FORM**

In accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, complaints may be filed by any person who believes that he or she has been excluded from participation in, been denied the benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under a program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance from the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), and believes the discrimination is based on race, color, or national origin. If you choose to file a formal complaint, you are asked to provide the following information:

**NOTE:** Any person has the right to file an anonymous complaint in person, electronically, or in writing. If you wish to file an in person complaint, please visit the address below Monday - Friday 6am to 4pm, and ask for the External Civil Rights Division. You will not be required to provide any identifying information in order to file an informal complaint, and no appointment is needed. However, if you elect to file a formal complaint with NDOT, it must be submitted in writing, signed and dated, within 180 days of the alleged discriminatory act (or latest occurrence). You are strongly encouraged to bring incidents of discrimination to the attention of the department as soon as possible after such conduct occurs. You may also file complaints directly with the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), or the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) within the 180-day period.
