





# Demolitions




- ✓ Kiewit has taken over the demolition process.

**PURPOSE OF MEETING:** The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) is hosting a public meeting to provide an update on Project Neon, which will begin construction this summer. Nearly two decades in the making, Project Neon is the largest public works project in Nevada history. The project will improve 3.7 miles of Interstate 15 between Sahara Avenue and the "Spaghetti Bowl" Interchange in downtown Las Vegas, currently the busiest stretch of highway in Nevada.

During the public meeting, you'll have the opportunity to learn about project highlights, including a new High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) direct connect between U.S. 95 and I-15, conversion of express lanes on I-15 to an HOV lane and general purpose lane, the new I-15 HOV interchange at Wall Street ("Neon Gateway"), reconstruction of the Charleston Boulevard interchange, the realignment of MLK Boulevard with a flyover at Charleston Boulevard, extension of Grand Central Parkway to Industrial Road and more. You'll also learn more about timelines for upcoming traffic changes, soundwall installations, and the schedule for development of new downtown connections. You can meet the project team, ask questions, and provide comments. *Parking is available at the school and in the City parking garage to the west of the school.*
