- Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities
- Traffic Calming
- Lighting
- ADA Improvements
- Non-Motorized Safety Infrastructure
- Safe Routes for Non- Drivers (including children, older adults, and individuals with disabilities)
- Conversion of Abandoned Railway Corridors for use by bicycles, pedestrians and other non-motorized users
- Historic Preservation & Rehabilitation of Historic Transportation Facilities
- Vegetation Management Practices
- Inventory, Control and Removal of Outdoor Advertising
- Archaeological Planning and Research
- Storm Water Management
- Wildlife Mortality Mitigation
- Restoration and Maintenance of Habitat Connectivity
- Boulevard Conversion
- Scenic Turnouts, Overlooks, and Viewing Areas
- Safe Routes to School related projects (must be within 2 mi of a K-8 school):
 - Projects that will substantially improve the ability of students (grades K-8) to walk and bicycle to school
 - Traffic diversions
 - Secure bicycle parking facilities
 - Regional Safe Routes to School Coordinators
 - Walking /Bicycling Encouragement programs
 - Education programs related to bicycle/pedestrian safety, health, and the environment
 - SRTS Training for volunteers and managers
 - Traffic Education and Enforcement
 - Public Awareness Campaigns
