The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration, Tahoe Regional Planning Agency, Tahoe Transportation District, U.S. Forest Service – Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit, Nevada Division of State Parks, Nevada Division of State Lands, Washoe County, Incline Village General Improvement District, Carson City and Douglas County, has worked to develop the *Nevada Stateline-to-Stateline Bikeway North Demonstration Project Joint Environmental Assessment* for the first three miles of shared-use path from Incline Village to Sand Harbor.

The project takes an integrated approach to improving safety, mobility, water quality, and recreational access in the SR 28 corridor. Although each of the major components (shared-use path, parking, safety and water quality improvements) may provide high value as independent construction projects, the project partners determined that the highest return value for motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists will be achieved when there is connectivity of the facilities, which in turn will provide the biggest improvement to the environment.

This public hearing, held from 4 to 7 p.m., is an opportunity to hear a presentation by project representatives beginning at 5:30 p.m., followed by a question and answer period from the audience. Project representatives will be available to answer your questions before and after the presentation.

During this meeting, and through May 13, 2016, you may make an oral statement to the court reporter that will be available throughout the meeting.





Project Location






Phase 1: Preliminary Design Elements Carried Forward

- First mile (3 total) of family friendly shared-use path
- Undercrossing at Tunnel Creek
- Safe pullouts for emergency vehicles and maintenance
- Connecting existing Lakeshore path with at grade crossing of SR-28
- Relocating and organizing parking near Ponderosa Ranch Road
- Enhancing the visitor experience with vista points, interpretive signs, and aesthetic treatments

- Realignment at 4th Street to Washoe County right-of-way




Phase 1: New Tunnel Creek undercrossing

Phase 2: Design Refinements


- Minor alignment adjustments to improve constructability and minimize environmental impacts
